If you are interested in receiving Measure AA funds - or if your project will be recommended for funding to the Restoration Authority Board - this workshop is for you. The SF Bay Restoration Authority requires that recipients of grants for construction projects of more than \$500,000, that are more than 10% of the project cost, enter into a Project Labor Agreement (PLA).

Such labor agreements are unfamiliar to most restoration project managers. This workshop will explain the Restoration Authority's requirements, share some templates and examples of PLAs, and discuss considerations in pursuing a PLA for your project now or in the future.
